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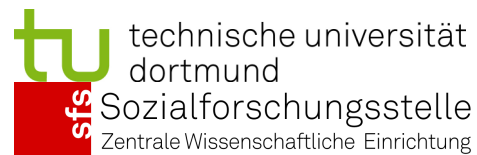

I-LINC Objectives

Objective 1) develop a wide, rich and active community of stakeholders – representing different target groups of young people (aged between 14 and 30) -, aspiring to become in the long run the largest European community in the field of ICT (for) learning and inclusion devoted to ameliorate youth employability.

Objective 2) Link existing stakeholders' activities in the field of ICT (for) learning and inclusion and join them in order to increase their impact both on policy-maker and end-user level.

Objective 3) Contribute to the improvement of existing platforms by creating a common off- and online space for open dialogue and meetings, and foster active mutual exchanges and peer-learning activities.

Objective 4) Define directions on how to improve tools and services for 1) the modernisation of education and training; 2) the employability of young people and 3) tackling the risk of digital and socio-economic exclusion (i.e. e-inclusion).

Objective 5) Contribute to the policy debate on how to support youth employment and entrepreneurship by means of e-skills development, digital inclusion and volunteering, and entrepreneurship skills.



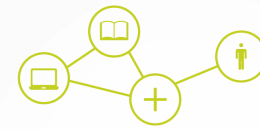
